**Technology Roadmap – FY2023 Major Projects – Smart Digital Enhancements and Infrastructure Technology Refresh (UCaaS – Telecommunications Platform)**

SERS Chief Technology Officer, Jay Patel, provided an update on the 5-year Technology Roadmap investment summary. Mr. Patel reported in FY 2023, SMART enhancements will total \$950K while updates to SERS IT infrastructure will cost roughly \$1.6M.

Mr. Patel also reported on UCaaS, SERS telecommunications platform. The UCaaS upgrade budget is \$250K and will be funded through the technology roadmap budget that was approved at today's board meeting.

Mr. Patel continued, reporting the UCaaS upgrades will allow SERS to provide mobile phone and tablet capability for members in the future. The committee looks forward to having the ability for members to be able to use mobile devices.

Mr. King thanked Mr. Patel for his presentation.

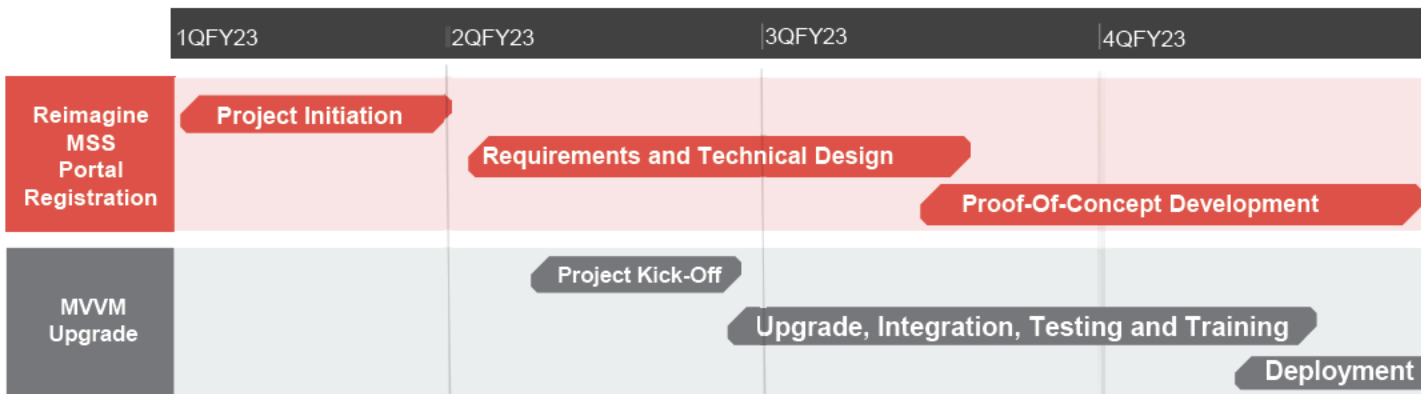

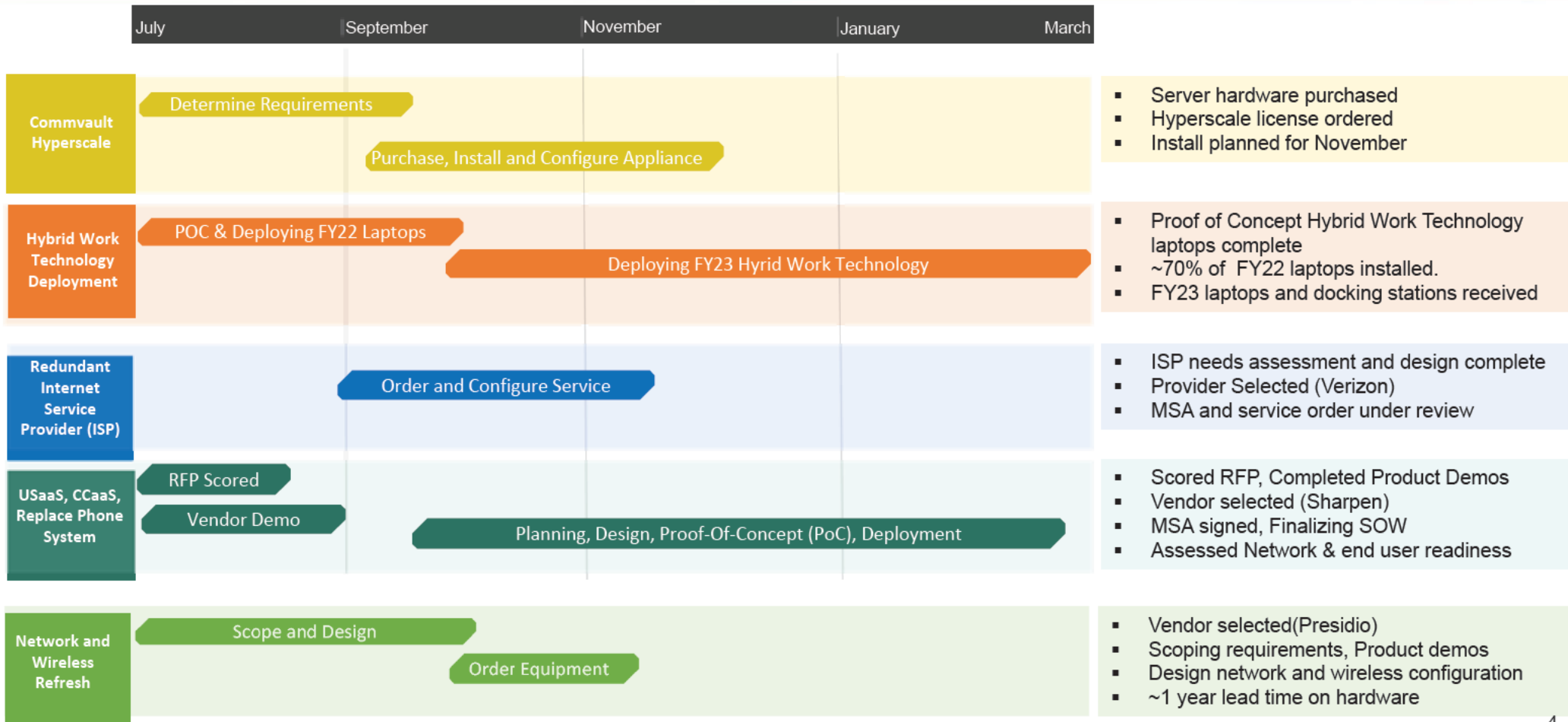
# Technology Roadmap – SMART Projects

  - Early discussion within IT about project scope, schedule impact, and training.



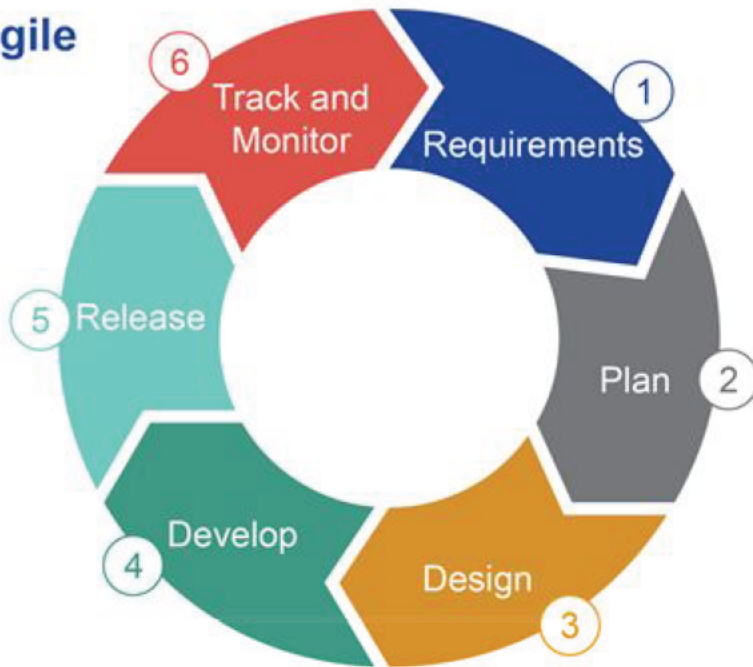
# Technology Roadmap – Infrastructure Projects



# Technology Roadmap Delivery Methodology



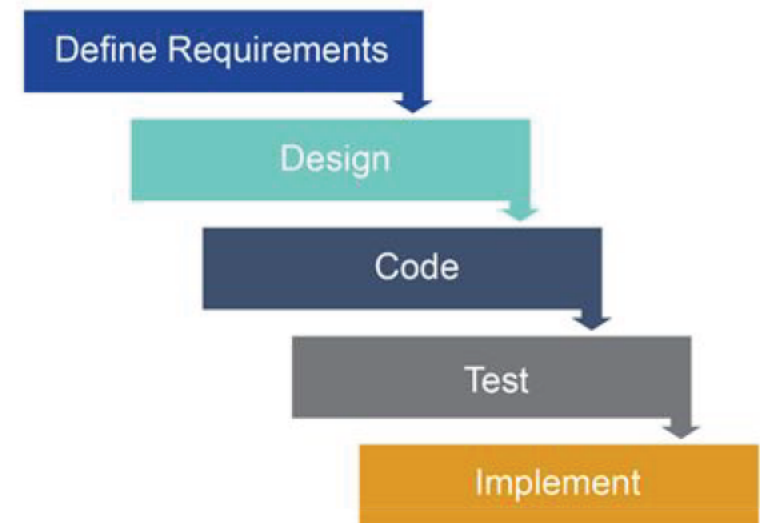
## Agile

- Customer involvement

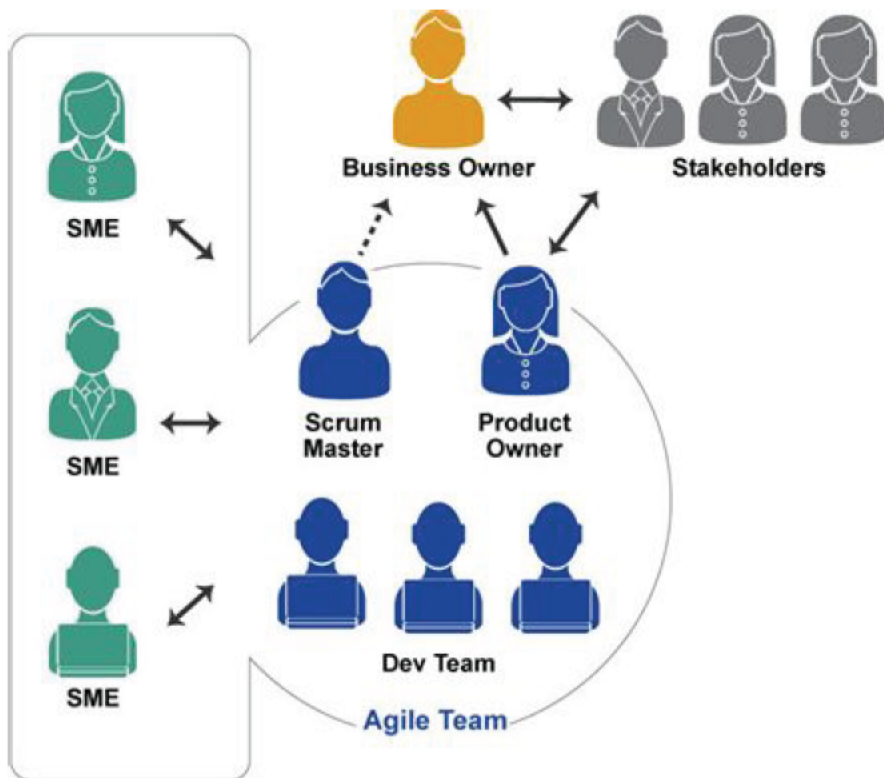
OR

  - Fail early, fail fast, and fail forward

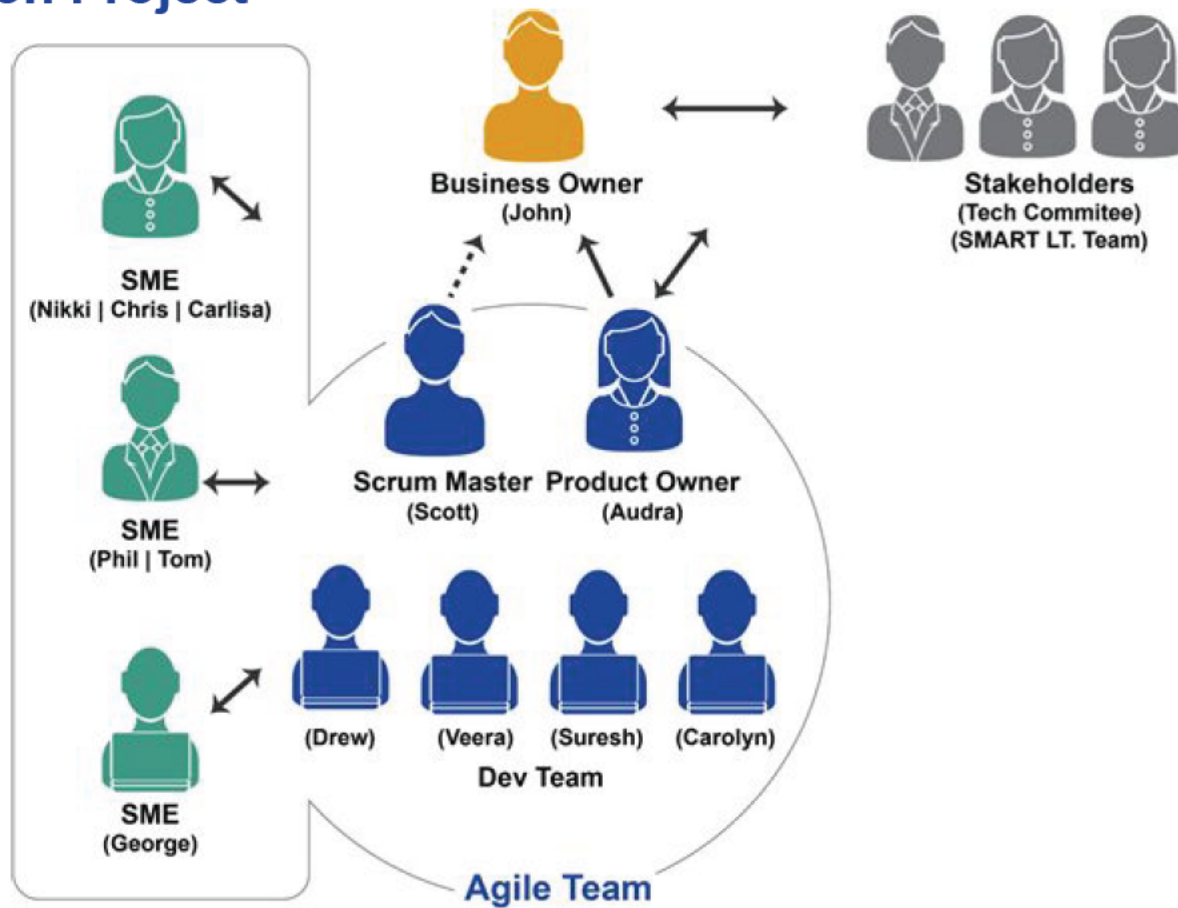
## Key Roles

Business Owner	The Business Owner is accountable for ensuring project objectives are aligned with the organization's strategy, ensuring customer's needs are in synch with the project's direction, and maximizing outcomes.
Scrum Master	The Scrum Master (aka – project manager) ensures team coordination and supports the progress of the project by facilitating collaboration and eliminating hurdles affecting project progress.
Subject Matter Expert (SME)	Subject Matter Expert (SME) has specialized knowledge and experience needed to support the scope of the project and actively participate and contributes to the successful completion of the project.

## **PENSION CUSTOMER EMAIL MESSAGE**

*Release to identified Pension Agency Executives*

RE: News from Sagitec

Hello Richard, Karen, and Jay,

I write today to share some news about Sagitec that, while not directly affecting our work with you, nonetheless merits notice.

On August 23<sup>rd</sup>, we learned that two of the leaders of our Labor and Employment line of business, David Minkinen and Siva Sambasivam, have been indicted on allegations concerning the theft of intellectual property.

The indictments arise from a government investigation in which we have fully cooperated. We expect a final resolution of the matter in the near future, and we will give you further details when that occurs.

In the meantime, I want to emphasize that:

- Sagitec was not indicted.
- The government's investigation does not relate to our pension practice.
- In particular, our Neospin™ product and our underlying Platform and Framework are not a part of this investigation.
- There is no indication that any other Sagitec employee is a target of the government's investigators.

We remain fully committed to our core values including achieving business results in an ethical and honest manner. In support of that commitment, we have further enhanced our compliance programs and will not tolerate conduct that falls short of our policies and values. Most importantly, we are committed to continuing to fulfill our commitments to you: Sagitec will be a reliable partner to you now and in the future.

As you might imagine, our ability to make further comments on this matter is limited, but I wanted you to be aware of this situation and to give you my assurance that our relationship with you and our ability to serve you is undiminished. We would be happy to schedule a meeting with you to talk about this matter and answer any questions you may have about it.
