

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends the following adult immunization schedule:

- COVID: Vaccination is recommended for everyone age 6 months and older.
- Flu: One dose every year.
- Pneumonia: Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV15 or PCV20) for all adults 65 years or older who have never received any pneumococcal conjugate vaccine or whose previous vaccination history is unknown.
- **Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV):** Adults 60 years and older should talk to their health care provider about whether the RSV vaccination is right for them. It is given as a single dose.
- Shingles: Two doses of Shingrix 2-6 months apart for adults age 50 or older regardless of past shingles episode or Zostavax vaccine.

COVID, flu, pneumonia, and shingles vaccines and their administration are covered at 100%. RSV is only covered for those age 60 and older with Prior Authorization from Aetna.

IF YOU GO TO A PHARMACY

RSV is only covered for those age 60 and older with Prior Authorization from Aetna	Show your Aetna ID card. The pharmacist will need to contact your doctor to submit a Prior Authorization request to Aetna.

If you are asked for payment at the doctor's office or pharmacy, you are responsible for paying the bill and requesting reimbursement from the plan providing coverage. Ask for an itemized bill and proof of payment.

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
