



MEDICARE EARLY DETECTION HEALTH SCREENINGS

Many early detection screenings are 100% covered by the SERS health care plans. The Summary of Coverage provided by your health plan includes detailed information on all screenings. The following are the most common screenings:

| HEALTH SCREENINGS | |
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| WOMEN'S HEALTH | |
| Annual Routine Physical Exam | Covered in full |
| PAP Test | Covered in full every 24 months |
| Mammogram (One baseline mammogram between ages 35 and 39. One screening mammogram for women age 40 and older.) | Covered in full once every 12 months |
| MEN'S HEALTH | |
| Annual Routine Physical Exam | Covered in full |
| Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) (For men age 50 and older) | Covered in full once every 12 months |
| Digital Rectal Exam (DRE) (For men age 50 and older) | Covered in full once every 12 months |
| IMMUNIZATIONS | |
| Influenza (Flu) Vaccine | Covered in full annually |
| Pneumonia Vaccine | Covered in full annually |
| Shingles Vaccine | Covered in full under your prescription drug plan (Part D) |
| COLORECTAL | |
| Fecal Occult Blood Test | Contact your plan to learn how frequently this service is covered in full before having this test performed. |
| Sigmoidoscopy | Contact your plan to learn how frequently this service is covered in full before scheduling the procedure. |
| Colonoscopy | Contact your plan to learn how frequently this service is covered in full before scheduling the procedure. |
| DIABETES | |
| Fasting Glucose (sugar) Blood Test (part of a diabetic screening) | Covered in full annually |

There are situations where these tests are prescribed by your doctor for medical reasons rather than for screening. In those situations, the test would be covered under Diagnostic/X-ray/Lab/Surgery plan coverage, and would be subject to your plan's deductible and/or coinsurance. Always confirm benefits with your health plan.

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
